David Franco has achieved international recognition as a practitioner architect, as educator and as scholar, since he started his career almost two decades ago. His academic and creative works have been awarded more than 16 prizes on International Architecture competitions such as European 6 and 7. He has been nominated for the prestigious Iakov Chernikov prize for young masters of contemporary architecture from the ICIF Foundation in Moscow. His articles and projects have been published on recognized international peer-reviewed journals, magazines and books, such as A+T (Spain), VLC Academic Journal (Spain), Arquitectos (Spain), A10 (Netherlands), European Generations (France), Arkitektur (Sweden), Byggekunst (Norway) or Bauwelt (Germany), among others. His projects have also been displayed on highly recognized venues, such as the 10th Venice Biennale, the Matadero Center for Contemporary Art in Madrid, or the 2nd Architecture, Art & Landscape Biennial of the Canary Islands

David holds a PhD on Architectural and Urban Theory from the Escuela Politécnica Superior USPCEU in Madrid, as well as a MArch and a Master of Advanced from the Universidad Politécnica de Madrid, both of which programs hold Accreditation Substantial Equivalency given by NAAB (only four programs in Europe have it). He is a licensed and architect in Spain since 2001, as well as registered in the Spanish Chamber of Architects.

He was appointed Associate Professor on Architectural Design at the Escuela Politécnica Superior USPCEU of Madrid in 2006, becoming in 2010 Director of the Architecture Thesis Program of the same University. In 2013, after moving to the US, he is appointed tenure-track Assistant Professor of Architecture at the University of Idaho. In 2014 he is appointed tenure-track Assistant Professor of Design, History and Theory of Architecture at Clemson University in South Carolina, where he currently teaches and researches. He has also lectured and reviewed as a visiting teacher in Universities and institutions in Madrid (Spain), Newcastle (UK), Ljubljana (Slovenia), Oslo (Norway), Bergen (Norway), Trondheim (Norway), Tromsø (Norway), Paris (France), Cottbus (Germany), and different cities in the US.

David is currently a member of the Editorial Committee of AMPS (Architecture, Media Politics and Society) academic journal. He has acted as Academic Assessor for the Masters and Bachelor Exam at the Bergen Arkitektskole in Norway, as well as jury member in International competitions such as European 8 in Spain. Since 2004 he has been a member of the Technical Committee of the European Europe Network, and since 2010 of the European Spain Scientific Committee.
