

## Mac OSX Setup

eduroam

1. Click on the **Wi-Fi** icon in the top menu.



- 2. Select eduroam.
- 3. When prompted, login to the eduroam network with your username@clemson.edu and password.

**NOTE:** Do <u>NOT</u> enter it in the format of a Gmail address. (i.e. username@g.clemson.edu) This will NOT work.

4. Then click **OK**.

NOTE: If you use Keychain, you will be prompted to save the Wi-Fi password in Keychain.

**NOTE:** If you see "tigernet" or "clemsonguest", remove these from the list by selecting them and clicking the **Remove Airport Network** — button.
