


## Submit your Assignment

1. Login to MyCLE.
2. Click the **Courses** tab.
3. Click the course link.




4. The system navigates you to the course home page.
5. Click the Assignment link that your professor provided.


## Submitting Turnitin Assignments



6. The assignment will be displayed. Click the **View/Complete** link.



7. Scroll down and click the **Submit** button.



8. Based on your professor's instructions select the item submission method required. This can be either **single file upload** or **Copy & Paste**.

## File Upload Option

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1. Select to submit a paper by **File Upload**.
2. Then enter your **Submission Title**.
3. Click **Browse** and select the file to upload.
4. Then click **Upload**.


