



Viewing your Originality Report and GradeMarks Beginner

1. Login to **MyCLE**.
2. Click the **Courses** tab.
3. Click the course link.




4. The system navigates you to the course home page.




NOTE: Some faculty will incorporate a link on their menu that will take you directly to **My Grades**.

5. Click the **Tools** button on your course menu.
6. Click the **My Grades** link.




7. Click the score in the **Grade** column for the selected assignment.



NOTE: Not all faculty make the Originality Report available to students.

8. The Turnitin Assignment Viewer will be displayed.
9. Click the **Originality** button at the top of the viewer to display your Originality Report. This will only be available if your professor has selected this in the setup of this assignment.
10. The numeric markers indicate additional sources that contained the selected information. The list on the right side of the page indicates the source where those materials were found.

11. Click the **GradeMark** button at the top of the viewer to view the feedback and QuickMarks that your instructor provided.
12. The blue markers on the document represent different QuickMarks. Hover over the QuickMark to see the details.
13. Your instructor may have provided additional comments and feedback about the overall document. These can be found in the **General Comments** pane on the right side of the Turnitin viewer.
