

Federal Regulations require international students to be enrolled in a full course of study while pursuing a degree in the U.S. under a student status. Full-time enrollment is usually defined as 12 credits for an undergraduate student and 9 credits for a graduate student. However, your program office dictates the actual number of credits necessary to maintain proper enrollment. Federal regulation requires **prior authorization** from International Services (IS) before the student reduces their course load. Failure to comply with this regulation will have severe, negative consequences on your ability to stay in the U.S. for study or work.

Please note, students are limited to **two reduced course load approvals per academic program**. Please plan accordingly. Once the form is complete, please return either the hard copy or a scanned copy of the form to the IS office.
