Immigration and Nationality Act (INA) defines the term "alien" as any person not a citizen or national of the United States. To comply with the state and federal laws, all international students (alien) must complete this **fillable** Form IS-300 and submit it to International Services (IS) at the beginning of study, along with the original relevant immigration documents.
