To retrieve phrases, put them in quotes.

The asterisk (*) is the wildcard; it allows for varied word endings.

Subject Headings help improve keyword searches

Sports - - Economic Aspects

soccer "economic aspects"

Communism and Religion; Communism and Christianity

marxi* christian*

+Scholarly clues: academic publisher/author; bibliography; in-depth coverage

Primary Sources in the Catalog

Look for these terms in subject headings or titles:

Correspondence = letters

- Diaries = a diary or a collection of diaries
- Personal narratives = memoirs or reminiscences Biography = also autobiographies
- Sources = official documents; collections of assorted primary source materials
- "Papers" = scholarly compilation of a person's (transcribed) writings

For example: Keyword: "South Carolina" diaries **Title:** Papers of Robert Mills
