Keyword Searches in the Library Catalog

hous\* history "south carolina" "domestic life" houses dwellings "domestic space"

To retrieve phrases, put them in quotes.

The asterisk (\*) is the wildcard; it allows for varied word endings.

Subject Headings help improve keyword searches

Architecture, Domestic--Italy--Rome "architecture domestic" pompeii

\*Scholarly clues: academic publisher/author; bibliography; in-depth coverage

# **Primary Sources in the Catalog**

Look for these terms in subject headings or titles:

- - Correspondence = letters • Diaries = a diary or a collection of diaries
  - Personal narratives = memoirs or reminiscences Biography = also autobiographies
  - Sources = official documents; collections of assorted primary source materials
  - "Papers" = scholarly compilation of a person's (transcribed) writings

For example: **Keyword:** "South Carolina" diaries **Title:** Papers of Robert Mills

Academic Search Premier - multidisciplinary, with many peer-reviewed journals, back to 1975 America: History & Life -- U.S. & Canadian history (prehistory to present)

Avery Index to Architectural Periodicals – international in scope, scholarly & popular coverage Historical Abstracts -- world history (excluding U.S. & Canada) 1450 to present

**JSTOR** – archive of over 1100 core scholarly journals
