Find Books & Publications in the Library

Clemson University Libraries Catalog

Search the Catalog to find out if the library owns a specific book or journal, or to see what books are available about a subject. Search by Keyword (for books about a topic), Author, or Title.

PASCAL Delivers

Don't find a book you need in our Catalog? Click the Pascal Delivers button to see if another South Carolina academic library owns the book, then at the click of a button request it be delivered within 3 days.

Find Articles & Research Publications

The library owns many indexes to help locate citations in journals and other publications. Access from the home page: <http://www.lib.clemson.edu>. Select "Find Articles" then follow the subject list to "Education." Although ERIC is the major indexing tool for education research, there are many other indexes that include related topics.

ERIC (Educational Resources Information Center)

ERIC is an information system sponsored by the U.S. Department of Education that generates the U.S. national bibliographic database covering the literature of education. The database consists of two files: document citations (ED) and journal article citations (JN) from over 750 professional journals. (Don't forget to use the Thesaurus!)

Education Research Complete

ERC is designed for professional educators and provides full-text access to education journals and reports.

Academic Search Premier & Expanded Academic

These two databases provide access to articles in a broad range of subject areas, and over half of them are full text. Many popular magazines and newspapers are included, and there is also current indexing for select journals in education.

PsychINFO

Index to journal articles, book chapters, and dissertations in psychology and related fields, 1872-present. (Remember that you can search both this and other databases at the same time)

Electronic Journals

Use the “**Locate a Journal**” link to search for a specific journal by title. Thousands of electronic journals are available. If you know the journal you want to search, use the Catalog to determine if it’s available online, then follow the links to access the journal. If you have a topic, but don’t know specific articles, use one of the article databases (ERIC, ERC) to search for your topic.

What if the Library doesn’t own the book / journal / dissertation / proceedings / etc. you need?

Interlibrary Loan

You may request books or articles from journals the library does not own by filling out an Interlibrary Loan form. Online forms are available at the Libraries’ home page. Articles and books are provided free of charge. The length of time it takes to get your article depends on many variables: how many libraries own the material, how busy their (and our) loan offices are at the time, the delivery method, and how detailed and accurate your request.

Does the Library have anything to help with my bibliography?

RefWorks

RefWorks is a bibliography manager that allows you to create your own personal database of citations by importing references from text files or online databases. You can use these references in writing your papers and automatically format the paper and the bibliography in seconds. To register or login to your RefWorks account, click on the **RefWorks** icon from the Libraries home page.
