Finding Books	To find books <i>about</i> an author, select <b>Subject</b> from the library catalog's pull-down menu and type the author's name (last name, first name) in the search box		
	To find books <i>written by</i> a particular author, select <b>Author</b> from the library catalog's pull-down menu and type the author's name (last name, first name) in the search box		
	If you know the <i>title of a book</i> and want to see if we have it, select <b>Title</b> from the library catalog's pull-down menu and type the title in the search box		
	To find books <i>about adolescent literature in general</i> , do a <b>keyword</b> search in the library catalog using some of the phrases/terms below (use the "" where indicated):		
	"best books" "young adult literature""yo"high school students" books reading"yo	oung adult fiction" oung adult literature" oung adults and books" outh and books and reading"	

Cooper Library has a small collection of books for children and young adults located in the Juvenile section on Level 3 near the elevators. In the library catalog, such a book will have the words **Children's/Young Adult** by the call number.

Don't forget to check the Library catalog for books about an author (see previous page for search tips). These books may contain criticism and/or bibliographies that will give you references to articles about the author.


To get to databases that will help you locate articles:

- Go to the Libraries homepage (www.lib.clemson.edu)
- Click on **Find Articles**
- Under Subject List, click on Literature

For your searches:

- First, try a search using the title of the books, putting those titles in ""
- If nothing comes up, try searching for articles about the authors of those works
- If you still get nothing, think of terms that describe a subject/theme discussed in the works (poverty, magic, etc.) and use that term, along with the terms **young adult\*** and **literature** to locate articles that discuss how other works of children's literature treat that idea

- Note the journal title, date, volume, issue, and page #s for the article
- Click the Check for & Check Clemson links to see if the Libraries subscribe to the journal

- If the book doesn't come up, do a search on the title of the book in the Library catalog

## Journals

If you come across a reference to a journal not listed below, do a *title* search on the *title of the journal* in the Library catalog.

UNLESS indicated otherwise by the titles below,

- *Current issues ("Latest Received")* of journals (past several months, usually) are shelved by call number in the Periodicals area on Level 4
- *Older issues* of journals (past year and before, usually) are on floors 1, 2, 5, or 6 according to their call numbers (Ps on level 2, Zs on level 6)
- *E-journals ("Online")* : use the **Locate a journal** link on the Libraries' homepage
