Academic Search Premier - covers all subjects, back to 1965

Lexis-Nexis -- full text newspaper articles, magazines, transcripts, legal materials

PAIS (Public Affairs Information Service) -- references to articles in political and social science journals, some government reports, international scope

Policy Central - political news, reports on key legislation, public opinion polls, etc.

CQ Researcher – in-depth analysis of contemporary issues, 1991 to present

Issues & Controversies - current controversial topics, 1995 to present
