



A Cleaner Cooler Cooper is Coming

Renovation work on the HVAC (heating/ventilation/air conditioning) system on the 1st, 2nd and 3rd floors of Cooper Library will begin this summer. The improvements made will enhance the circulation of air in the library and alleviate problems with humidity and temperature control.

Schedule:

May 23-Dec. 31:	1 st and 2 nd floors closed
Nov. 20-Feb. 20:	3 rd floor closed
Feb. 20-April 20:	Entire building open but limited air conditioning
June 19-Aug. 18:	Administration offices on 4 th floor closed


Fond Farewell...
