This series is arranged alphabetically by folder title and then chronologically within each folder. Most of the material in this series consists of legislative bills and reports. Some correspondence and memos, as well as newspaper/magazine articles, can be also found in this series. The major subjects of this series are the U.S. House Agriculture Committee, education, tax bills, and tobacco. In addition, materials on economic recovery, nuclear waste, public opinion, the Republican Study Committee, social security, and telecommunications are filed in this series. Specific legislation, programs, and problems reflected in this series include the Coastal Barrier Resources Act, Myrtle Beach erosion, the Rural Electrification Administration Lending Program, and the Union Camp Paper Mill Issue.
