#### Series 15: Audio/Visual Series, 1973-1991; bulk 1974-1984

27.559375 cubic feet consisting of 156 cassette tapes, 22 reel-to-reel tapes and 44 video tapes.

The Audio/Visual Series consists of audio cassette tapes, reel-to-reel audio tapes and video tapes.

Materials in this series cover the period 1973-1991. The bulk of the materials dates from 1974 to 1984 and contain audio and visual materials that pertain to Steorts' career, especially the periods when she was the Special Assistant to the U.S. Secretary of Agriculture for Consumer Affairs (1973-1977) and Chairman of the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (1981-1984).

The series consists of two sub-series: **Audio Materials** and **Visual Materials**. **Audio Materials** are arranged alphabetically by the titles. **Visual Materials** are arranged both chronologically and alphabetically because some of the video tapes have more than one subject on them.

The **Audio Materials** (Sub-series 15.1, 9 boxes, .559375 cubic feet) contain audio tapes which mainly relate to Steorts' work as the Special Assistant to the U.S. Secretary of Agriculture for Consumer Affairs (1973-1977). Many of the tapes were made by Steorts and her staff, as well as other individuals attending the events. Steorts and other individuals, e.g., U.S. Secretary of Agriculture Earl L. Butz, make comments on the audio tapes. The audio tapes cover such topics as looking at the consumer through history, the changing role of women in the workplace, consumer choices are the driving force of a market economy, management perspectives and politics, re-pricing in supermarkets, and food prices. Other topics include Steorts' testimony on home canning lids and an interview with her regarding portion choices. In addition, there are cassette tapes related to conferences like the Food Editors' Conference, the Mid-America Red Meat Marketing Conference and the White House Conference on Consumer Representation. Furthermore, there are audio tapes related to the women's marketing firm, Successful, Inc., which was founded by Susan A. Davis and Nancy Harvey Steorts in Washington, D.C. in 1979. Topics of those audio tapes include success in communications, success in entrepreneurship and success in management.

The **Video Materials** (Sub-series 15.2, 6 boxes, 27 cubic feet) contain video tapes which pertain to Steorts' work as the Chairman of the U.S. Consumer Product Safety Commission (1981-1984). Many of the video tapes were made by monitoring/media companies, as well as Steorts' staff at the Consumer Product Safety Commission. Steorts and other individuals appear in the video tapes. The video tapes cover such topics as kerosene heaters, elderly consumers safety project, toy safety, Johnson & Johnson's Tylenol crisis, formaldehyde, as well as fire protection and smoke detectors. Also included is a video tape of the press conference regarding Steorts' resignation as Chairman of the U.S. Consumer Product Safety in November 1984. However, it should be noted that a few video tapes relate to the Dallas Citizens Council, the 1985 Trade Mission Trip to Europe (England, Germany and Spain), and the Malcolm Baldrige National Quality Award.
