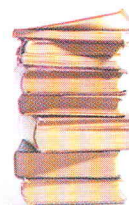

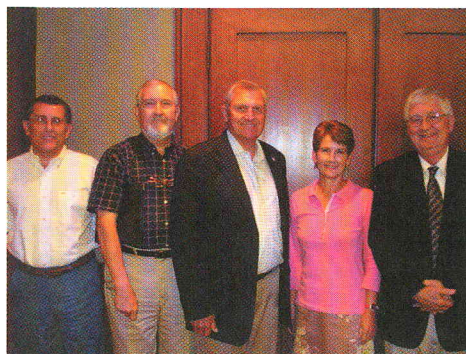

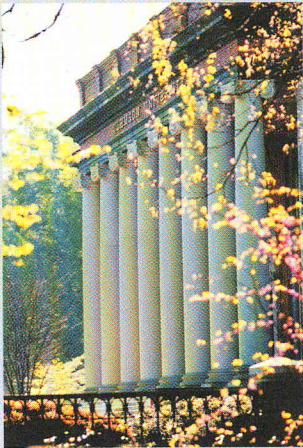


New Board Members Begin Duty

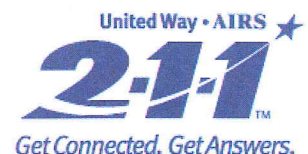
SPECIAL FEATURE: Volunteer Opportunities

wish lists. If you prefer to check information online, go to www.sc211.org. And don't forget to give to the United Way!

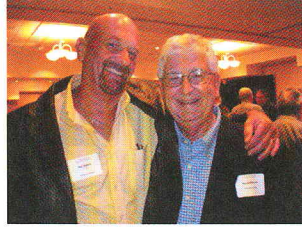


Success Stories: Emeritus Events

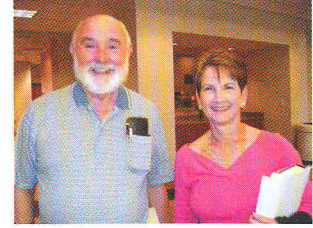

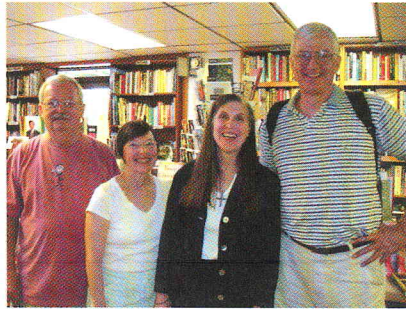

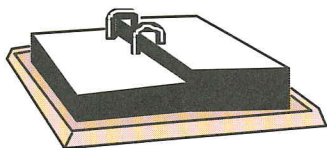
