# Shorescaping Demonstration Growing Strong

On May 7<sup>th</sup>, Sumter County planted a shorescape along the edge of the main pond at Patriot Park to reduce erosion issues and minimize fertilizer washing into the pond. The badly eroded bank was planted with ornamental grasses and native wildflowers, including the button bush pictured at left, to create an attractive buffer to protect the shoreline and the pond.
