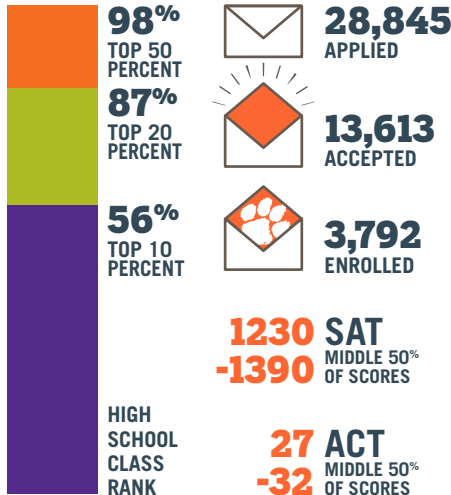

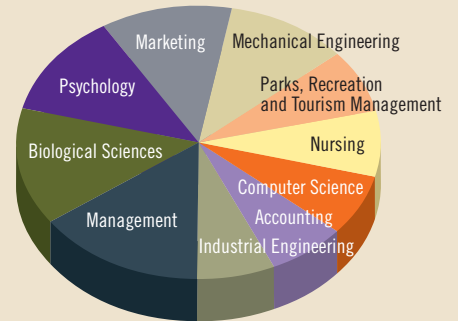

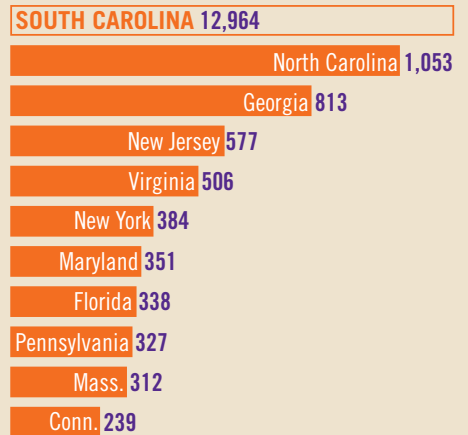
TEN MOST POPULAR DEGREES

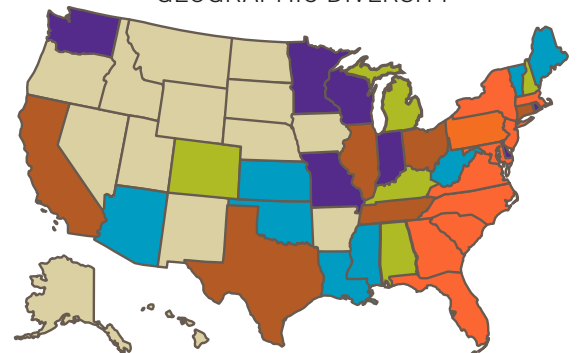
TOP TEN STATES FOR UNDERGRADUATE ENROLLMENT
