## Peer-Assisted Learning (PAL)

## Tutoring

### Service Description

Individual and small group appointments facilitated by a peer tutor who has successfully completed the course. During a tutoring session, you can ask topical questions and work with a tutor on specific course concepts and material while discussing personalized and effective study strategies. Tutoring sessions are offered throughout the week for around 50 courses. Additionally, Study Skills tutoring sessions allow students to work collaboratively with a tutor to brainstorm effective learning approaches for any course.
