



Pre-Business Curriculum Worksheet (2017-2018)

This worksheet outlines required courses for this major. Students are expected to be familiar with general education and major-specific requirements for their intended major as outlined in the Clemson *Undergraduate Announcements*. Additionally, students must satisfy any Tri-County prerequisites for the courses below. Students must earn 30 credits at Tri-County and a 2.5 GPA during their Bridge year to complete Bridge program requirements. If any of the following requirements are met through dual enrollment and/or AP/IB credit or students wish to enroll in other courses, consult the *Undergraduate Announcements* and the Bridge Student Academic Guide for additional coursework that fulfills major and Bridge academic requirements. These worksheets are supplemental planning aids and are for informational purposes only.

**** Pre-Business is not a degree-granting program.** Students who have successfully completed the Bridge Program must complete the Pre-Business freshman core (courses listed below in **BOLD**) and have a cumulative GPR of 2.0 or better before being admitted into a degree-granting business program (*exception: Marketing requires a 3.0 GPR*). Students must complete the freshman core and declare a business major by the end of their fourth semester. However, in order to maintain timely progress toward graduation, students should declare a major by the end of their second semester. Registration for 300-and 400-level business courses may be restricted to students in their degree major.

¹ MAT 130/230 (MATH 1020/2070), MAT 140/141 (MATH 1060/1080), or MAT 140/230 (MATH 1060/2070) sequences are acceptable. If a student elects to take MAT 140/MAT 141, one credit hour will be applied toward the elective hour requirement. For College of Business students, completion of Math 1020/2070 is crucial for pre-requisite purposes. Failure to complete math may result in limited class availability at Clemson University. Please consider all options such as retesting for Accuplacer and summer classes.

² If ENG 101 + 102 is taken for English Composition requirement, ENG 102 should be taken instead of the Science and Technology in Society requirement.
