

NOTE: Advising worksheets are supplemental planning aids. Every effort is made to ensure accuracy; however, it is the student's responsibility to understand and meet degree requirements as stated in the applicable Undergraduate Announcements. Pre-Business is not a degree-granting program. All Pre-Business students must complete the Pre-Business freshman core (core courses listed below in **BOLD ITALICS**) and have a cumulative grade-point average of *2.0 or better before* being admitted into a degree-granting business program (exception: Marketing requires a 3.0 GPA). Students must complete the freshman core and declare a business major by the end of their fourth semester; however, in order to maintain timely progress toward graduation, students should declare a major by the end of their second semester. Registration for 3000- and 4000-level business courses may be restricted to students in their degree major.
