Fines and Fees Report
Fiscal Year 2014

Proviso 117.79 of the FY 2014-15 State of South Carolina Appropriation Act requires a reporting of aggregate fines and fees charged and collected in the prior fiscal year.

Fees and charges are classified in three general groups, Regulatory Established Fees, Board of Trustee Approved Fees and Other Fees.

Regulatory Established Fees

Clemson University collects a fee of \$30 for checks returned by the bank. In FY 2014 \$18,820 was collected in returned checks fee charges. SC Code of Laws Title 34, Chapter 1.1, Section 70 authorizes a charge for a returned check. Revenues collected for the returned check charge is used to support collection costs for returned checks.

Clemson University operates a Municipal Court. Municipal Court fines and fees are established in the SC Code of Laws Title 14. Assessments related to the fines are required to be remitted to the State Treasurer's Office. An annual audit of the Schedule of Municipal Court Fines/Assessments and Remittance is required to be sent to the State Treasurer's Office. A copy of the report is available. Revenues collected by the municipal court (after assessments are remitted to the State Treasurer) are used for the municipal court operation.

Board of Trustee Approved Fees

Clemson University derives its authority to assess student fees in accordance with the South Carolina Code of Laws, Title 59, Chapters 101, 112, and 135. Student Fees are approved by the Board of Trustees as part of the Budget approval process. (See attachment). Other Fees

117.79, (GP: Fines and Fees Report) In order to promote accountability and transparency, each state agency must provide and release to the public via the agency's website, a report of all aggregate amounts of fines and fees that were charged and collected by that state agency in the prior fiscal year. The report shall include, but not be limited to: (1) the code section, regulation, or proviso that authorized the fines and fees to be charged, collected, or received; (2) the amount received by the source; (3) the purpose for which the funds were expended by the agency; (4) the amount of funds transferred to the general fund, if applicable, and the authority by which the transfer took place; and (5) the amount of funds transferred to another entity, if applicable, and the authority by which the transfer took place, as well as the name of the entity to which the funds were transferred. The report must be posted online by September first. Additionally, the report must be delivered to the Chairman of the Senate Finance Committee and the Chairman of the House Ways and Means Committee by September first. Funds appropriated to and/or authorized for use by each state agency shall be used to accomplish this directive.

1. Online programs include Human Resource Development, Youth Development & Leadership, Public Administration, Industrial Engineering and non-thesis Biological Sciences.
2. The Graduate School has clarified that a full-time graduate student (including a graduate assistant) is classified consistently by enrollment in a minimum of nine credit hours per semester for all university purposes (approved Fall 2012).
3. The Audit Fee has been removed from the Fall 2013 Fee Schedule. Previously the fee was calculated at 50% of tuition, however, due to best practices the calculation has been updated to be 100% of tuition and thus removed from this document.
4. Clemson University is actively participating and soliciting nationally competitive fellowships which include a predetermined tuition & fee support amount. In order to remain competitive the departments will have the option to apply a waiver to cover the difference between the predetermined tuition & fee support and Clemson's tuition & fee rate (approved Fall 2012).
5. The Undergraduate Student Government has established the Student Sustainability Initiative (i.e Green Fee) for Fall 2013 academic year. The fee is a \$10.00 opt in fee that will be managed by the Undergraduate Student Government.
6. The Summer Experiential Program Fee is being proposed for the upcoming Summer Session. The fee will be a variable rate that would cover travel costs associated with the innovative summer courses and programs that are being developed commensurate with the Road Map 2020 goal to increase summer school activity.
