Synergistic Activities

Jennifer Schumpert is an early childhood teacher that has experience working with three-year old children through grade four. Ten of her years teaching public school was as a K-4 teacher while also working with other age children in the summers and as a homebound teacher. As a K-4 teacher, she streamlined and organized the registration process for incoming K-4 children in Oconee County. During her time in Oconee County, she also became a certified trainer for Creative Curriculum. She also served as a member of the First Steps Board in Oconee County for two years. She also designed professional development workshops for K-4 teachers in Oconee County.

Jennifer Schumpert is a Master Trainer for the South Carolina Center for Child Care Career Development. She has written numerous proposals for trainings and has facilitated workshops for child development centers in Oconee County, Pickens County and Greenville County. She has also contracted with the South Carolina Center for Child Care Career Development to write two trainings on Mathematics and the South Carolina Early Learning Standards.

Jennifer Schumpert is a contributing author of Math Out of the Box®, a K-5 standards-based, inquiry mathematics curriculum, which was developed in the College of Engineering and Science at Clemson University from January 2001 to June 2008. This project also developed a comprehensive professional development program to introduce and sustain this curriculum. This project was funded by the publisher Carolina Biological Supply Company, Clemson University, DuPont, the General Electric Foundation, the American Honda Foundation, and Michelin North America.

Jennifer Schumpert developed and delivered professional development for a US Department of Education Teacher Quality grant administered by the South Carolina Commission on Higher Education: Building a Mathematical Learning Community (\$312,500, 1/1/2006-6/30/2009). This project built and sustained a mathematical community of learners in selected Greenville County schools in South Carolina that had consistently demonstrated a need for improvement in the areas of mathematics instruction and student mathematical achievement. Professional development for whole schools and by grade level was provided to enhance teacher content knowledge and pedagogical knowledge.

Jennifer Schumpert designs, develops, and delivers professional development for the Professional Development for Integrated Inquiry project. This project develops and provides professional development for Math Out of the Box, inquiry mathematics, inquiry science and literacy. This project contracts with schools and districts, holds institutes and workshops, and provides fee-based on-site staff development.
