**“Member Masters” Saturday, April 12**

New event this season. The “Member-Masters” will be held on Saturday, April 12 in conjunction with “*The Masters*.” Walker Course members will sign up to play golf on Saturday and pick any professional playing in *The Masters* that day as their partner! Each member’s NET score will be added to their professional partner’s score from Saturday’s round at *The Masters* for the team total. You will only be competing against other members that play from the same set of tees. The deadline to sign up is Thursday, April 10th, at 12 noon. Entry fee is \$20 (plus cart fees). The entry fee forms the golf shop credit prize distribution jackpot. The golf staff will make all pairings.

**Twilight Couples: April 25**

Your annual Couples Spring Twilight will take place Friday evening, April 25<sup>th</sup>. Member couples will be paired with another couple to form a four-person team for a nine-hole scramble. Following play, we will gather at *Solé On The Green* for drinks and snacks. Entry fee is \$50 per couple (plus cart fees). Golf prizes and drinks/snacks are included. **Match Play Championship**

The 2025 member’s Match Play Championship begins May 7th. This championship is a “net” event with full course handicap stroke differences being used in each match. You must have a GHIN handicap to participate. Members will sign up to play by “tee” divisions. Entry deadline is May 4th, and pairing matches will be posted on Tuesday, May 7<sup>th</sup>. ### "First Friday Free-For-All"

Last month we met with the Friday member's golf group leaders to discuss the situation about the lack of equal access for all members to Friday morning tee times. As our membership has grown, so has the demand for Friday morning tee times. The Friday member groups hold 2/3 of all tee times available before 1pm. This has restricted the number of available tee times for the rest of the membership.

After discussing a few options, we are going to run a "test program" called the "First Friday Free-For-All." On the first Friday of May, June, and July there will be NO GROUP TEE TIMES "pre-reserved" for any groups. This will allow all members equal access to the available tee times beginning two weeks prior at midnight. Any member wanting to play on those First Fridays will have to access the available tee times through the online member portal two weeks prior. You will only be allowed to reserve ONE tee time per log-in. Groups will need to have one person responsible for making a tee time for a foursome. **March Status**

March has seen temperatures warm up slowly and consistently and things were a little bit on the dry side.

On March 4<sup>th</sup>, we were able to make our course wide application of slow release fertilizer and summer pre-emergent weed control. The course was dry and firm, allowing the bulk truck to access all areas of the course with no issues.

We were also able to scalp down all the rough to 1 inch to get rid of the excess dormant material. This will allow us to get a better cut throughout the growing season.

The two extra cups in the greens were removed at the end of the month.

**April Goals**

April sees us return to more routine mowing and maintenance and less project type work as the grass greens up and begins to grow.

We will perform a micro tine aeration of the greens on Monday April 14<sup>th</sup>, with 1/8<sup>th</sup> inch tines to improve water infiltration and gas exchange, and to help us manage organic matter in the upper rootzone. There will be little, if any impact on ball roll, especially after rolling the greens a couple of times. These are the same tines we used late last summer. Testing has shown the organic matter levels of our greens are on the high side, therefore we must get more aggressive in managing it.

The mats on holes 4 & 12 will be removed around mid-month. We need some warmer weather to get the grass growing a little more so that we will get recovery from divots. Unfortunately, there are a lot of divots on some of these tees now from players who did not follow the rules. Thanks to all of you who did cooperate by using the mats this winter.

**Driving Range Project**

There is little to report on the driving range. Not much has occurred in March with our portion of this project. We are waiting for the parking lot contractor to finish importing the fill needed to get the tee and green area up to grade, so that our contractor can do the detailed shaping and irrigation and drainage installation. Rerouting of the three major irrigation lines began but is not complete. We are also waiting on a decision from the university on the removal of Delta Street.

**Rounds 4 Research Auction April 21-27**

This year's Rounds 4 Research auction takes place April 21 through the 27<sup>th</sup>. This auction of tee times was founded here in the Carolinas and is now nationwide. The Walker Course is proud to donate a Stay & Play package to this great cause that raises money for turfgrass research. Money raised from this program has funded over \$850,000 in turfgrass grants for research at Clemson University and North Carolina State University.
