

Digital Measures – Guide for Contracts, Fellowships, Grants, Sponsored Research (Funded Projects)

The Clemson University Faculty Success team has uploaded proposals originally stored in InfoEd and transferred them to Faculty Success.

There are a few things to consider when viewing this page.

Report Year

Data from funded projects comes out of InfoEd. The report year is based on the fiscal year, so report year 2018-2019 would mean fiscal year 2019. We have designed the screen so that Faculty Success reports will pull fiscal year data to match the review year. Do not be concerned if you see May dates – those are included to coincide with the Faculty Success reporting structure. The data under consideration runs on a fiscal year basis, which would mean that report year 2018-2019 covers data from July 1, 2018 until June 30, 2019. Report year 2019-2020 covers data from July 1, 2019 until June 30, 2019. Project expenditures will be updated throughout the summer to reflect the end of the fiscal year, and department chairs should keep that in mind as they are performing annual reviews.

Project Team Members/Project Totals

These numbers represent award allocations and project expenditures in the fiscal year.

Principal Investigator/Co-Principal Investigator

The title and the Abstract list the principal investigator. All other faculty who are in Info-Ed show up as Co-Principal Investigators. The Clemson Faculty Success team is working with the Watermark Faculty Success Technical Staff to move the role and allocated percentage into the main area of the screen so it can be updated. Once that happens, the team will populate that information from Info-Ed as well.
