#### Simple Syllabus required for all courses beginning Fall 2025

The current syllabus repository will be permanently removed during the Summer of 2025. Beginning Fall 2025, Simple Syllabus will be our only repository solution and **will be required for all courses**. This software is integrated into Canvas, though it can also be used independently of Canvas through a <u>Simple Syllabus direct link</u>.

Clemson Online will host the next Simple Syllabus training on April 8.
