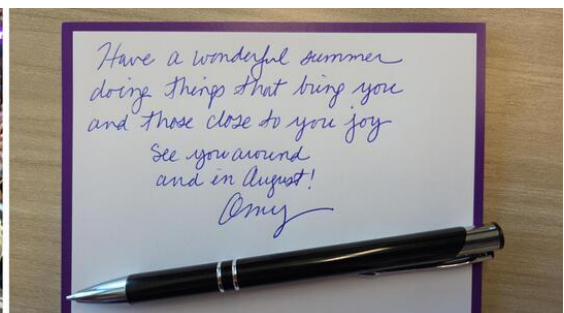

## Renew an education abroad program


