- All-Hazards approach

## On-Scene Coordination

- Organize on-scene operations using the Incident Command System
- Ensure key locations are established
- Establish check-in processes
- Identify key contingency plans
- Project expansion of the incidents and needs
- Coordinate Regional Resources
- Establish planning cycle

## Emergency Operations Center

- Focus
  - Supporting responders
  - Continuing University Operations
- Centralize the command, control, and coordination
- Coordinate support from county, state, and federal resources
- Develop, coordinate, and execute University & site restoration plans for impacted areas
- Bridge to Executive Leadership Team during emergencies
