Steps to getting and using a new 3D printer:

1. Contact OES for an assessment of the location where the printer will be located.
2. Once the new printer is received and setup, go to SciShield and register the printer.
 - OES 3D Printer Manager can assist with registration process.
3. Contact OES if filament used changes
 - PLA is standard filament, other filaments require OES assessment
