EPA's TSCA Methylene Chloride (MC) non-Lab Regulations

April 2024, EPA finalized prohibitions and workplace protections under the Toxic Substance Control Act (TSCA) for the use of Methylene Chloride (i.e. Dichloromethane, DCM, Methylene bichloride, or Methylene dichloride) in non-labs.

The above products are just a few that were previously made with MC. Currently there is a permissible use of MC is limited to commercial and industrial applications. Full phase out of MC products is expected in the next 2 years.

If possible:

- Consider alternative products that do not contain MC.
- Ensure that your inventory accurately represents how much MC is in the non-lab.
