Libby Kehn serves as executive assistant within the Office of the Vice President for Student Affairs and Dean of Students. Kehn assumed her position in April 2019 and was later elevated to the Student Affairs Leadership Team (SALT) after the interim vice presidential appointment of Dr. Chris Miller. In her role, Kehn manages the day-to-day operations of the Vice President's Office, including meeting schedules, contact with students and families, and student staffing and payroll.

Kehn was an assistant director within Clemson's athletic communications office from 2006-19. She began her career as webmaster for ClemsonTigers.com, managing all aspects of the school's official athletics website for 19 varsity sports in addition to multiple departments. From 2014-19, she served as publicity contact for several sports while managing event staffing, interview coordination with student-athletes and coaches, student payroll and administrative office tasks. In 2018, she facilitated the credential management system for local and national media during Clemson football's third national championship.

Kehn is a native of Saline, Michigan and owns two degrees from Clemson. She graduated with a bachelor's degree in management in 2002 and added a master of business administration in 2004. She served as an undergraduate and then graduate assistant within Clemson's sports information office from 1998-2004.
