Gamma Phi Beta was founded on November 11, 1874 at Syracuse University, becoming the first female organization to coin the term "sorority." More than 145 years later, there are currently about 180 collegiate and alumnae chapters across the U.S. and Canada with more than 246,000 initiated members and counting.

The Epsilon Theta Chapter at Clemson University was founded on April 9th, 1988. Each of our sisters exemplify Gamma Phi Beta's four core values: Love, Labor, Learning, and Loyalty. Our mission is to build confident women of character who celebrate sisterhood and make a difference in the world around us.


