A tuberculin test is a screening used to identify tuberculosis (TB) exposure. It is not an immunization. It does not protect you from getting Tb infection. An Interferon Gamma Release Assay (IGRA) is required for any student who has resided or traveled out side of the U.S. for more than two weeks within the last five years or has other TB risk factors. This includes countries where tuberculosis is endemic. Students will be REQUIRED to be screened upon arrival to Clemson or provide proof of screening performed in the U.S. within the past 12 months. **TB screenings performed outside of the U.S.** or **PPDs will not be accepted**.
