## HOW TO APPEAL: Academic Renewal

A student who has not been enrolled at Clemson for a period of two or more academic years may apply to the Appeals Committee on Academic Eligibility for readmission under special conditions known as academic renewal. If granted, the student's GPA is reset, although all previously earned credits will no longer count toward a degree. Write a letter to the committee stating the following:

- 1. Reasons for any former academic difficulty and reasons you now feel ready to earn your degree. If you had a serious personal issue that inhibited your success, describe how this issue has been overcome.
- 2. If you plan to change your major, tell what the new major will be, develop a plan of action as to how you will be successful in that major, and develop a relationship with an advisor in that major.
- 3. If you do not plan to change your major, develop a plan of action as to how you will be successful in your current major, and develop a relationship with an advisor in your major department.
- 4. Highlight any academic progress you've made while away from Clemson. Include unofficial transcripts.
- 5. Specify the things you will do to be successful and graduate.

**Please keep the letter concise -- approximately one page**. All letters should be typewritten, neat, and with good spelling, grammar, and punctuation. The letter should be as professional as possible.

Your letter **MUST** include a header with this info:

- o Your name
- o Mailing address
- CUID number
- $\circ \quad \text{Telephone number} \\$
- E-mail address

(if any of this information is excluded, then your appeal will not be complete and will not be presented to the committee.)

**Letters of recommendation are important**. You are strongly encouraged to submit a letter from your academic advisor, instructor, employer, etc. in support of your continued enrollment. Those writing letters of recommendation can **EMAIL** their letter to <u>UGSeligibility@clemson.edu</u>. Please submit a maximum of three letters of recommendation.

If you would like for your academic advisor to provide feedback on your appeal, please have them complete the <u>Advisor Feedback Form</u> by the appropriate deadline. If you have taken courses elsewhere, this can be submitted by your academic advisor at that institution

## APPEALS WILL BE GRANTED ONLY IN THE MOST EXCEPTIONAL CASES.
